**SUBJECT:** **Scales Used for Weigh-Ins**

In accordance with the Rules of the New York State Athletic Commission only scales that are approved by the Commission may be used at any weigh-in.

The attached information will be given to all boxers, seconds and managers at the weigh-in to make them aware of this rule. This information will be provided in English and Spanish.

## **UNAUTHORIZED WEIGH-INS**

**BOXERS ARE REMINDED OF SECTION 209.46 OF THE RULES OF THE STATE ATHLETIC COMMISSION THAT REQUIRES THAT ALL SCALES USED FOR ANY WEIGH-IN MUST BE APPROVED BY THE ATHLETIC COMMISSION. THE ONLY SCALES APPROVED BY THE COMMISSION ARE THOSE USED BY THE COMMISSION. THEREFORE, BOXERS ARE INSTRUCTED NOT TO PARTICIPATE IN ANY WEIGH INS OTHER THAN THOSE CONDUCTED BY THE COMMISSION. VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION MAY RESULT IN SUSPENSION OF A BOXER'S LICENSE OR PERMIT.**
