Enrollment Documentation Check list

Please see below to determine what types of documentation you will need to bring.

Income Information:

1. Most recent **1040 Form** from U.S Individual Income Tax Return
2. Schedule C - "Profit or Loss Statement" (If you're self-employed.)

Wages and Salary (for a period of at least 4 weeks)

- **Last 4 weeks of Paycheck stubs**, or
- Letter from employer on company letterhead, signed and dated

NY State Unemployment Benefits (Only **one** of the following documents)

- Monthly benefit statement from NYS Department of Labor
- Printout of recipient's account information from NYS Department of Labor's website

Citizenship or Immigration Status: You only need to bring **one** of the following documents

1. US Citizen (If you were born in the USA)

- NY State Identification card or Drivers License

2. Naturalized US Citizen

- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550, N-570), or
- U.S. Passport book or card

3. Immigrant: Non-Citizen or Non-Immigrant Visa holder

- I-551 resident alien card (green card), or
- I-94 arrival/departure record, or
- I-766 employment authorization card, or
- Document from United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS)
