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Minutes of the NYSAC Medical Advisory Board
September 18, 2013

Dr. Jordan called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

The first order of business was to welcome and introduce the new Medical Advisory Board members.

The second order of business was to review the minutes of the Medical Advisory Board meeting dated January 16, 2013. The minutes were reviewed and unanimously approved.

Review and vote on applications for panel physician (executive session)

The MAB unanimously approved the application of Dr. Robert Martin Biernbaum to become a panel physician for the NYSAC

Discussion of mouth piece with an accelerometer

Dr. Jordan presented information a mouthpiece which contained an accelerometer which was being used as an investigational device to measure head acceleration following trauma. There was a discussion about the advantage of the mouth piece compared to other telemetry systems such as the Helmeted Impact Telemetry System (HITS) used in football. There was a general discussion whether boxers would be willing to wear this type of device and whether this could be used in studying boxers.

New business/Open discussion

There was a discussion regarding the King-Devick (KD) test. Dr. Jordan explained that this was rapid reading visual test that was initially designed as a visual tracking test but was now being investigated as a tool to assist in the diagnosis of sports concussion. Dr. Jordan briefly demonstrated how the test was administered. It was noted that the NYSAC would be conducting a pilot study to determine whether the KD test would be feasible to be perform on our boxer's pre and post fight. It was noted that the Standardized Assessment of Concussion (SAC) was currently being used as part of the pre-fight annual physical.

There was also a discussion of devising educational pamphlets for boxers and that the NYSAC website was hosting information on concussion and dehydration. Potential topics to disseminate information to boxers included MRSA and use of steroids.

There was a discussion regarding the current policy of the NYSAC not allowing a boxer to enter the ring wearing a knee brace. After a general discussion of the pros and cons of a boxer wearing a knee brace, there was a general consensus to maintain the current policy.

The MAB meeting was adjourned at 7:00 pm


