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## Commission Bulletin 2014-2

### Weigh-In Procedure

The Commission will designate the location of all weigh-ins.

The scale on which the boxers will be weighed at the official weigh-in will be available to the boxers for at least one hour prior to the official weigh-in.

In a non-title bout, a boxer will have one opportunity to get on the scale at the official weigh-in. The boxer will not be permitted to get on the scale a second time, except that a boxer who is over the contract weight may remove undergarments and accessories and step on the scale a second time immediately after the boxer's first time on the scale. If a boxer is not at or below the contracted weight, the boxer, the boxer's opponent and the promoter may re-negotiate the bout agreement.

In a title bout, if a boxer is not at or below the contracted weight when he or she gets on the scale at the official weigh-in, the boxer will be given up to two hours to attempt to make the contracted weight.

The Commission reserves the right to take disciplinary action against any boxer who fails to weigh in at or below the contracted weight during the official weigh-in.
