Introduction and Recommendation

I received an application (Exhibit A) for the repair of 73 hazardous monuments located in the Green Hill Cemetery in the City of Amsterdam, Montgomery County. The application was submitted by Paul Damiano, President of Green Hill Cemetery. Included with this application is one estimate from Pickett Memorials (Exhibit C) for memorial repair totaling \$28,215. The cemetery attempted to obtain another estimate but was unsuccessful. Included with the application is a letter from cemetery trustee, Peter Betz, explaining that the cemetery had contacted two other memorial dealers (Letter, McFee) and both declined the offer to submit an estimate because they said it is a time consuming process with no guarantee of being awarded

the contract. I agree with this assessment of the hazardous monument application process and see this as becoming a more common occurrence, especially with rural cemeteries. Also included was a legal notice (Exhibit C) that ran for three consecutive weeks in The Record (6/17/20, 6/24/20, 7/1/20)

I recommend approval of this application.

The Monuments

I visited the cemetery on June 8, 2020 and found that all 73 monuments under application were either loose on their foundations or tipping and appeared to pose a hazard to cemetery visitors and employees. The cemetery has had no response to the legal advertisement which it placed, and has no funds dedicated to the restoration of monuments. Based on the advanced age of the monuments in question, it is assumed the foundations were laid privately by either the families or by monument contractors.

The Pickett Memorials memorial repair estimate proposes to reset the monuments on the new foundation and seal all joints. They offer a ten-year warranty.

Recommendation

The cemetery is current with its payments to the vandalism fund, with the filing of its annual reports and the previous grant was used appropriately. All documents appear to be in order, and this appears to be a legitimate claim for \$28,360.68 I recommend that this application be approved.

You are correct that we did not include two quotes on our 2020 Repair of Dilapidated Monuments application Form, for the following reason.

If you examine our previous application forms over the past years you will see that we did always include two quotes. However, I cannot get any of the previous competitive bidders of reputable and competent businesses in the immediate area to give us any more quotations. They have all informed me that it takes too much time with no certainty of winning the contract. This includes such firms as Letter Memorial of Gloversville (bid two years then stopped), McFee of Canajoharie (bid once, then stopped). There was one other firm that only bid one year but I can't remember the name of it. Before sending the current application I called a firm in Schenectady but the man told me, "We've been through that too many times and it's just a time-waster."

I spoke with Mr. Breen about the situation before he left and he told me to mail in the application anyway. I don't know what else to do at this point other than to contact firms farther from our area. Please inform me if you want me to try this.

Also please note the single page with several markers shown. For some reason these did not record on the disc I sent you and we only discovered this later.

The following proposal and related information is offered in conjunction with the application for repair or removal of dilapidated or disrepair monuments that create a dangerous condition in the Green Hill Cemetery, Cornell Street, Amsterdam, New York.

The proposal covers 73 monuments listed from #1 (Illegible) Snell to #73 Marie Marsellus.

The proposal follows guidelines outlined by the NYS Division of Cemeteries and the Green Hill Cemetery Association including:

All work will be done under the supervision and direction of the cemetery association.

With submission of this proposal, Pickett Memorial warrants that all workmanship and products (concrete/cement, construction grout, TDQ (Thin, Deep, and Quick Repair), setting/sealing compound, granite epoxy or industrial caulk, et al) will be of the highest industry standards.

For new and cap foundation work, monuments will be disassembled, temporarily moved, and reassembled and resealed using compound as required. Once reassembled, granite – to a lesser degree marble – monuments are expected to last decades plus. Pickett Memorial warrants that the reassembly and resealing of each monument will have a ten year warranty. Products used are subject to manufacturer's warrant. Properly installed cemetery foundations, as required by guidelines, are similarly expected to remain functional for the foreseeable future. Foundations of the required composition and dimensions, should similarly

last decades. Foundations are warranted for ten years. Products used are subject to manufacturer's warrant.

Warranties do not extend to vandalism or acts of nature.

A Certificate of Liability Insurance designating the Green Hill Cemetery as the Certificate Holder and proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance, NYS Disability are provided.

Pickett Memorial will follow the required foundation guidelines in product and dimensions. Guidelines require: "... all foundations for all upright and slant monuments must be to a minimum of 36" and to 42", if 42" is required by the cemetery association." Officers of the Green Hill Cemetery Association have requested a 42" depth.

It has been our experience that many of the older (50+ years) foundations have an established rock, rock/cement or concrete base foundation below ground level. Slate, stones and/or gravel mixture were then used to level the monuments as the bottoms of the monument base were often left rough/not smooth or level. In such cases, a foundation concrete cap is poured on top of the established solid foundation with a mortar finish to assure stability. Foundation cap depth dimension is determined after the monument has been removed. Rebar and remesh are used to strengthen the cap and eliminate any shifting or movement. Each listed memorial foundation is individually probed to determine depth. Existing solid stone, slate, concrete composite foundations are designated to be capped (Column 9 of the Hazardous Monument Application Spreadsheet – Green Hill Cemetery attached). Monuments set on only loose stone, rubble, minimal concrete slab or dirt are considered to have no foundation and thus a new foundation will be installed with depth/existing depth following guidelines.

As noted, the final decision to pour new or cap each foundation is made once the monument has been moved and the condition of the existing or lack of foundation is determined. Foundations which have sunk, lean, monuments leveled by use of slate wedges, are shallow, uneven due to loose stone/slate/composite, show substantial deterioration or are non-existent are costed to pour new. Foundations designated to be capped are level but comprise of loose stones/slate/bricks, crack concrete/clay composites and show signs of significant erosion and/or deterioration.

The length and width of each foundation is listed in column 7 of the attached 'Hazardous Monument Application Spreadsheet – Green Hill Cemetery.' The depth of concrete poured is determined as to whether a new or capped foundation is determined. The overall depth, new or existing, will meet guideline requirements.

Foundations will be installed so they are level and solid, with no movement. Similarly, each reset monument will be level, straight and sealed, either new or previously permanent.

When capping or installing a foundation, Pickett Memorial only uses concrete gravel/sand compound (Quikrete and/or an industrial grout). We do not use 'wedging' as means to level or fortify a monument setting.

When moving the monuments, care will use to preserve the existing seal. Existing permanent seals which are intact after resetting will not need to be resealed. Where the seal is broken or nonexistent, Monument Setting Compound (Granite City Tool Company) will be used in resetting. All joints shall be sealed with setting/sealing compound, granite epoxy or industrial caulk. The seal will be between two like materials as granite to granite and marble to marble.

Certain special setting techniques may be required when reassembling/resetting older monuments/spires. Many times the bottom of the base of an old monument is not flat. Thus, the monuments were set on a stone foundation allowing the base to be settled into the foundation. To accommodate an uneven base, we may need to use a dry cement or mortar mix in the top inches of a foundation to guarantee 'no movement' when monument adheres to the foundation. This process will be determined once the monument has been removed from the existing stone foundation.

Of the monuments listed none were considered candidates to lay flat, or be removed and replaced with a granite or bronze marker (Columns #11 - #17 are, thus, filled in as non-applicable).

The total cost of this proposal for the 2020 season is \$ 28,215.00.

1. By posting this notice and information concerning your rights as an injured worker, your employer is in compliance with the Workers' Compensation Law.
2. If you do not notify your employer within 30 days of the date of your injury your claim may be disallowed, so do so immediately.
3. You are entitled to obtain any necessary medical treatment and should do so immediately.
4. You may choose any doctor, podiatrist, chiropractor or psychologist referred by a medical doctor that accepts NY State Workers' Compensation patients and is Board authorized. However, if your employer is involved in a certified preferred provider organization (PPO) you must first be treated by a provider chosen by your employer and your employer must give you a written statement of your rights concerning further medical care.
5. You should tell your doctor to file copies of medical reports concerning your claim with the Workers' Compensation Board and with your employer's insurance company, which is indicated at the bottom of this form.
6. You may be entitled to lost time benefits if your work-related injury keeps you from work for more than seven days, compels you to work at lower wages or results in permanent disability to any part of your body. You may be entitled to rehabilitation services if you need help returning to work.
7. You should not pay any medical providers directly. They should send their bills to your employer's insurance carrier. If there is a dispute, the provider must wait until the Board makes a decision before it attempts to collect payment from you. If you do not pursue your claim or the Board rules that your injury is not work-related, you may be responsible for the payment of the bills.
8. You are entitled to be represented by an attorney or licensed representative, but it is not required. If you do hire a representative do not pay him/her directly. Any fee will be set by the Board and will be deducted from your award.
9. If you have difficulty in obtaining a claim form or need help in filling it out, or if you have any other questions or problems about a job-related injury, contact any office of the Workers' Compensation Board.

3. Usted tiene derecho a recibir cualquier tratamiento médico necesario relacionado con su lesión y debe gestionarlo inmediatamente.
4. Para el tratamiento de cualquier lesión o enfermedad relacionada con el trabajo, usted puede escoger cualquier médico, podiatra, quiropráctico ó psicólogo (si es referido por un médico autorizado) que esté autorizado y acepte pacientes de la Junta de Compensación Obrera. Sin embargo, si su patrono está autorizado a participar en una organización certificada de proveedores preferidos (PPO), usted deberá obtener el tratamiento inicial para cualquier lesión o enfermedad relacionada con el trabajo de la correspondiente entidad. Patronos que participen en cualquiera de estos programas establecidos por ley están obligados a proveer a sus empleados notificación escrita explicando sus derechos y obligaciones bajo el programa a que esté acogido.

Disability Benefits For Employees

1. If you are unable to work because of an illness or injury, not work-related, you may be entitled to receive weekly benefits from your employer, his or her insurance carrier, or from the Special Fund for Disability Benefits.
2. To claim benefits you must file a claim form within 30 days from the first date of your disability, but in no event more than 26 weeks from such date.
3. Complete claim form DB-450 (Notice and Proof of Claim for Disability Benefits)
You may obtain the form from your employer, his or her insurance carrier, your health provider, any Unemployment Insurance Office, the Workers' Compensation Board's website (www.wcb.ny.gov) or any office of the Board.
IMPORTANT: Before filing your claim, your health provider must complete the "Health Care Provider's Statement" on the form showing your period of disability.
 - o If you are employed, or have been unemployed for four weeks or less when your disability begins, send the completed form to your employer or the insurance carrier named below.
 - o If you have been unemployed more than four weeks when your disability begins, send the completed form to the Workers' Compensation Board, Disability Benefits Bureau, 328 State Street, Schenectady, New York 12305.
4. You are entitled to be treated by any physician, chiropractor, dentist, nurse-midwife, podiatrist or psychologist of your choice. However, unlike workers' compensation, your medical bills will not be paid unless your employer and/or union provide for the payment of such bills under a Disability Benefits Plan or Agreement.
5. If you are ill or injured during the time you are receiving Unemployment Insurance Benefits, file a claim for Disability Benefits as soon as you sustain the injury or illness, by following the instructions outlined above.
6. If you are out of work in excess of seven days, your employer is required to send you a Disability Benefits Statement of Rights (Form DB-271S).
7. You may not take disability benefits at the same time as paid family leave benefits. The total amount of disability and paid family leave in a 52 week period cannot exceed 26 weeks.
8. Other information about disability benefits may be obtained by writing or calling the Workers' Compensation Board.


