Due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) Emergency, the State and Federal bans on large meetings or gatherings, and pursuant to Governor Cuomo's Executive Order 202.1 issued on March 12, 2020, and subsequent Executive Orders issued thereafter, certain provisions of the Open Meetings Law have been suspended. The Governor's Executive Order provides that public bodies may meet to take such actions as are authorized by the law, without permitting the public in-person access to such meetings, and authorizes meetings to be held remotely by conference call, provided that the public has the ability to view or listen to such proceeding and that such meetings are recorded and later transcribed.
