CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF

FIRST: The name of the corporation is:

SECOND: The corporation is a benefit corporation under Article 17 of the Business Corporation Law.

THIRD: The purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the Business Corporation Law. The corporation is not formed to engage in any act or activity requiring the consent or approval of any state official, department, board, agency or other body without such consent or approval first being obtained.

FOURTH: The specific benefit purposes of the corporation, if any, are:
