**Notice of Review for the**  
**Town of Porter**  
**Draft Local Waterfront Revitalization Program**

In accordance with the New York State Waterfront Revitalization of Coastal Areas and Inland Waterways Act and the New York State Coastal Management Program, the Town of Porter, located within Niagara County and the Western NY region, has prepared a Draft Local Waterfront Revitalization Program (LWRP). The LWRP is a comprehensive management program for the Town's waterfront resources along the Niagara River, Lake Ontario, and Six Mile and Four Mile Creeks.

To approve the Town of Porter LWRP pursuant to Article 42 of the NYS Executive Law, it is required that potentially affected State, federal, regional and local agencies be consulted to assure that the program does not conflict with existing policies and programs. The Town of Porter Draft LWRP was accepted by the New York State Department of State (DOS) as complete and is now available for review by potentially affected State, federal, regional and local agencies, and the public. Comments on the Draft LWRP are due by **September 22, 2020**. At the close of this required review period, DOS will coordinate with the Town the responses to comments and any necessary revisions to the LWRP. Following adoption of the LWRP by the Town, and its subsequent approval by the Secretary of State, pursuant to 15 CFR Part 923, Subpart H, DOS will request incorporation of the LWRP into the State's Coastal Management Program by the federal Office for Coastal Management (OCM), as a Program Change.
